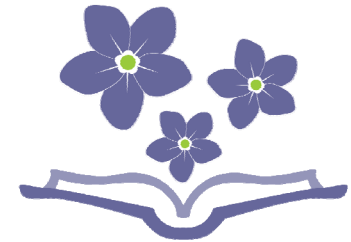
The four libraries are the **Delafield Public Library, Hartland Public Library, Pewaukee Public Library, and Town Hall Library**.

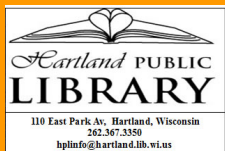

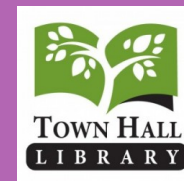
